- Always open

HOW TO PREPARE

PAPER AND NEWSPRINT

go in the green and gold bins.

- Newspapers, including glossy inserts
- Junk mail
- · Office paper
- Magazines

Please no plastic bags or carbon copies

No books (except at the West Main station, which has a separate bin to receive books, including phone books.)



PLASTIC, METAL AND GLASS

go in the dark green bin

Plastic includes only #1 and #2 containers for:

- Soda
- Water
- Salad dressing
- Milk
- · Laundry and cleaners

Remove and discard lids. Rinse and flatten, if possible.

Do not recycle:

- Plastic bags or wrap
- Styrofoam
- No containers used for motor oil, paint, solvents, chemicals, auto products, lawn products

Container Glass

- All colors
- · Beverage bottles
- Food jars

Remove and discard lids Rinse to remove all food and drink residue

Do not recycle:

- Prinking glasses/dishes
- Mirrors
- Window glass
- Light bulbs

Metal

- Tin food cans
- Aluminum and steel beverage cans
- Aluminum foil and pie pans
- Aerosol spray cans (must be empty)

Remove and discard lids Rinse to remove all food and drink residue

Do not recycle:

- Cans for chemicals or paint
- Appliances or power tools
- Batteries
- Clothes hangers

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

must be broken down to fit through a 5-inch slot

Includes food boxes in which the food is in liners, such as cereal boxes (remove liners)

Do not recycle: Anything with direct contact with food, such as pizza boxes
